

Booster Meeting Minutes
Tues. April 13/10

1. **Call to Order-** The meeting was called to order at 7:15 by Mike Connolly, president. Present at the meeting were Regina Granchelli, William Vona, Ryan Ennis, Roberta Wojcinski, Brian Lachell, Ginny Edbauer, Cono Sammarco, David Mullane, Ellen Roth and Cindy MacDonald.
2. **Secretary's Report-** There were a few errors in the March minutes. Corrections are as follows: Regina Granchelli and Todd Fragale's names were omitted from the attendee list and have been added, there were no updated financial, \$100 was allotted for First Aid training for the softball coaches and this too was omitted. New minutes were submitted and approved.
3. **Treasurer's Report-** Brian Lachell was present. There are a couple of adjustments this month. On 12/1/09 a payment was made to ESM Enterprises Inc. for basketball uniforms in the amount of \$922.00. \$210 of this amount needs to be removed as the girls paid for this portion. New total is \$712.00. Therefore, after the adjustment, this month's projected balance is \$548.29.
4. **Old Business-**
 - a) Alumni Tournament- Ryan Ennis reported that there was one more team entered this year. Easter weekend made it tough for some to attend. Next year they will target more DeSales grads, recent grads and those that didn't go to DeSales HS. Ryan hopes to improve the number of sponsors, and the refs worked for free. They would like to see more parents attend the party. Net total for the event was \$1,333.25.
 - b) Spring Sports- Ginny Edbauer reported on soccer. They are lacking coaches, and getting a later start this year with little time for practices. There has been some overlap with intramural basketball which caused a conflict. There are 5 teams and 88 kids. There is a tournament June 5/6, that is optional and up to coaches and teams. Mike reported that intramural basketball needs to be reevaluated for next year, with an earlier start in Feb/March and with possibly doing away with the 7/8 team. Gym space is at a premium. 72 kids are registered. Softball has 2 varsity teams of 12 girls. Track is being run by Mike Screen and has over 100 kids. There was some miscommunication with the track fee, as the note sent home stated a \$10 fee which is wrong and for those who have paid, the money will be returned. Mike C. will follow up with an email letting the families know of the change. Last year \$388 was spent and there is no budget for this year.
5. **New Business-**
 - a) First Aid- Ginny and Cono Sammarco will look into arranging a class at the end of the summer or early fall for a small group and will talk to Sheila Lawrence regarding this. The class will be paid for by the Boosters.

- b) Volleyball- Parents have been asking for volleyball and the Diocesan does have it. This will be pursued more to see what the options are and if anyone is interested in coaching. Questions will be directed to Regina and Roberta Wojcinski will check what the YMCA has to offer. Mike C. will check for interest amongst families..
- c) Recognition for Ulrich signs and DMI for baskets and court lines. Mike is thinking of getting decals of their signs to put on the backboards to show our appreciation for their generosity. Mike will talk to Chris McCaffery about making the signs.
- d) Track- funding requests: Mike sees the need for 8 aluminum batons at \$3.19 each, totaling \$25.52 and 8 stop watches at \$11.99 each totaling \$95.92, and possibly some ribbons, for a total of just over \$122.00. \$125 was approved for this equipment. The stop watches will be returned to school and can be used for swimming.
- e) Roberta needs a request sent out for all uniforms to be returned.
- f) Look for a budget meeting to be scheduled for the May meeting.
- g) New officer nominations will take place at the May meeting with voting to take place at the June meeting.
- h) Cono will send notes regarding the meeting for the Baseball tournament.
